Remarks: No trace of stopper. Fragments of cover on ashes, which began about 9-10 inches below top of urn.

Contents:

- I. A. Top Layer: Contents passed through sieve.
B. Bottom layer: Residue left in sieve after sieving.
- II. A. Top layer: Amulets; 11 shell beads, pierced & graduated in size; 1 amulet; small fragment of silver; 1 burned shell; 11 single, small beads & 6 masses of the same, of unknown material, also graduated in size; fragments of a fragrant substance.
B. Second layer: Osseous fragments, teeth, & carbonized material.
C. D. Third & bottom layers: Osseous material & carbonized matter picked out with tweezers.
