- (B) AL-YAMAN (mod. Yemen, “righthand”)
- (C) TIGRAY (part of Abyssinia, border of mod. Eritrea & Ethiopia)
- (D) ABYSSINIA (mod. Eritrea & Ethiopia), centered at SHEWA
 - ① Massawa and Arqiqo (Red Sea ports); Dahlak Island (Portuguese outpost)
 - ② Axum (ancient capital) and Adwa (battle site, victory over Italian invaders)
 - ③ Lalibela (quarried churches)
- (H) AL-SUDAN (land of the “blacks”)
- (E) AL-SUDAN (land of the “blacks”)
- (F) SOMALIA
- (G) ZANZIBAR (“rust coast”)

(J) **SULI**, **SUGUDA/SOGDIANA**, **CHAGATAI KHANATE** – steppe, **Land of Horses**

(4) **Samarkand** (**Maracanda**)

major Silk Road town, capital of Sogdiana

(5) **Kashgar**

major Silk Road town, eastern Chagatai khanate (mod. Xinjiang, persecution of Uyghurs)

(H) **HUVĀRAZMĪŠ/CHORASMIA**

Aral Sea delta, not visited by Xuanzang, birthplace of al-Biruni (973-1050 CE)

(K) **TUKHARA**, or **BĀXTRIŠ/BACTRIA** – “Land of Gems” (i.e. lapis lazuli)

(6) **Balkh** (**Bactra**)

major Silk Road town, capital of Bactria

(L) **GANDĀRA/PAROPAMISUS** – Kushan dynasty kingdom of **Kanishka** (ca.127-147 CE)

(10) **Bamian**

site of colossal Buddhas visited by Xuanzang (destroyed by Taliban)

(11) **Kapisha** (**Alexandria in the Caucasus**)

refounded by Alexander (campaign of 330-325 BCE); Begram Air Force Base, prisoner-torture (Dec 2002)

(R) **HARAIVA/ARIA** – etymological root of Aryan

(7) **Herat** (**Alexandria Areion**)

refounded by Alexander (campaign of 330-325 BCE), Northern Alliance uprising (Nov 2001)

(S) **HARAUVATIS/ARACHOSIA**

(8) **Kandahar** (**Alexandria in Arachosia**)

provincial capital of the Persians, refounded by Alexander (campaign of 330-325 BCE), Panjwai massacre (May 2012)

(9) **Tsaukuta** (**Alexandria in Opiana**), **Gazna** (mod. Ghazni)

refounded by Alexander (campaign of 330-325 BCE); capital of Ghaznavid Mahmud (ca.998-1030 CE)

(C) **ΘΑΤΑΓΟΥŠ/SATTAGYDIA, PUNJAB** – “Five Rivers” Upper Indus Valley

(12) **Takshashila** (**Taxila**)

key city of **Ashoka** (ca.268-232 BCE), capital of Sattagydia; controlled by **Delhi sultanate**

(P) **HINDUŠ/INDIA, SINDH** – Lower Indus Valley, “Land of Elephants,” early Islamic conquest

(M) **KASHMIR**

modern territorial dispute between India and Pakistan
